PROGRAMS IN STUDY

32% PARTICIPATION

183 Programs in 77 schools, 13 states, 5 Federal Education Regions

Programs: 78% (143) Day 1% Residential (2) 20% (38) Day/Residential

PLANS: 1,815 TRANSFER STUDENTS

RESULTS FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

60% (1,088) plan to enter/return to In-district programs

23% (415) plan to enter/return to In-district Regular Education,
including supported inclusion

37% (673) plan to enter/return to Other In-district education,
e.g., resource room, alternate school, self-contained LEA

PLANS: 789 GRADUATES/AGED-OUT STUDENTS

♦ **Male 70%** (552)

Female 30% (237)

♦ **Race/Ethnicity:** 56% (444) White 28% (227) Black 11% (92) Hispanic
3% (26) Asian (19), .5% American Indian/Alaskan Native (3) and
Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander (4)

♦ **Length of Stay:** 74% (582) enrolled < 5 years

♦ **Exiting Students by Specialized Program:**
31% (246) Developmental 45% (358) Emotional/Behavioral
11% (78) Medical 13% (107) Learning

RESULTS FOR GRADUATES/AGED-OUT STUDENTS

♦ **93%** plan to enter a Mainstream, Vocational Rehabilitation,
or Community-Based Activity

- **37%** (292) to 4-Year/2-Year College or Trade/Technical School

- **17%** (134) to Competitive Employment or Military

- **27%** (216) to Vocational Rehab or Supported/Sheltered Employment

- **12%** (95) to Community-Based Programs

- **1%** (8) to Other Post school Activities

- **6%** (44) with No Immediate Postschool Plans

♦ **54%** plan to enter 4-Year/2-Year College, Trade/Technical
School or Competitive Employment/Military
