- 61% (1,347) plan to enter/return to In-district programs
- 29% (643) plan to enter/return to In-district Regular Education (16% with IEP Prescribed Supports)

GRADUATES/AGED-OUT STUDENTS: RESULTS

- 90% (905) plan to enter a Mainstream, Vocational Rehabilitation, or Community-Based Activity
- 32% (323) to 4-Year/2-Year College or Trade/Technical School
- 15% (153) to Competitive Employment or Military
- 25% (251) to Vocational Rehab or Supported/Sheltered Employment
- 18% (178) to Community-Based Programs
- .4% (4) to Other Post-school Activities
- 9% (93) with No Immediate Post-school Plans
- 47% (476) plan to enter 4-Year/2-Year College, Trade/Technical School or Competitive Employment/Military
